If students are interested in tutoring a specific course, please fill out the **green application form**. **Qualifications include:**

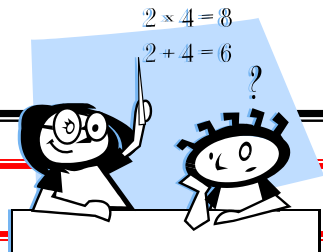
final grade of B or better in the course tutoring, overall good academic standing, and a referral or reference from professor.
