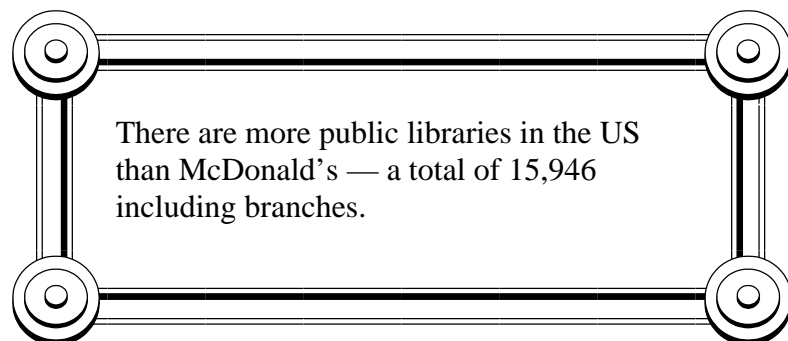

Coincidence or Math Magic?

How many people do you need in a group to ensure at least a 50 percent
probability that 2 people in the group share a birthday?

Let's take a show of hands. How many people think 30 people is
enough? 30? 60? 90? 180? 360?

Surprisingly, the answer is only 23 people to have at least a 50 percent
chance of a match. This goes up to 70 percent for 30 people, 90 percent
for 41 people, 95 percent for 47 people. With 57 people there is better
than a 99 percent chance of a birthday match!
