To celebrate, the UW-Fox Valley Library is holding a book sale of books and other materials donated to the library. The sale will be held from February 1-10 during library hours.



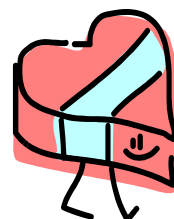
Winter Olympics, Turino, Italy
