The March issue of *National Geographic* is titled "Saving Energy:It Starts at Home." It states that most of us could reduce our energy costs by 25% with a little effort and not much money.

For example, the average house is 45% larger than 30 years ago.

If we drove just 20 miles less a week, we could save 107 million tons of CO<sub>2</sub> a year.

If we turned off our computers at home when not in use, 8.3 million tons of CO<sub>2</sub> would be saved.

If we converted all of the lightbulbs to compact fluorescents, we would reduce CO<sub>2</sub> by 42.4 million tons.
