

Fox Valley Engineering Graduation Process

- ☑ Complete an “Intent to Graduate” form two semesters prior to the final semester. Forms are available from the program office or at the following link:
http://www.uwplatt.edu/registrar/files/graduate_form.pdf

- ☑ If there are transfer credits or exemptions/waivers in the record, these must all be documented and approved by UW-Platteville. It is important to verify this information with an advisor prior to submitting the “Intent to Graduate” form.

- ☑ The UW-Platteville Registrar's Office will initiate a final evaluation of a student's credits when the "Intent to Graduate" form is submitted. This evaluation will formally review all credits taken, transferred, or substituted/waived, and detail which course work remains or has not yet been taken.

- ☑ Commencements are held twice each year on the main campus--at the end of the fall and spring semesters. All coursework (including co-ops, internships) must be completed before a degree will be awarded, and attendance at a Commencement ceremony is permitted.
