



UW-Platteville B.S. Mechanical Engineering CORE GPA REQUIREMENTS

Each student must complete the following seven core courses with at least a 2.60 Core Grade Point Average (CGPA) to gain entry into the Mechanical Engineering program:

- ENG 101 – English Composition I (3 cr.)
- MAT 221 – Calculus and Analytic Geometry I* (5 cr.)
- MAT 222 – Calculus and Analytic Geometry II* (5 cr.)
- EGR 105 – Engineering Fundamentals (3 cr.)
- GRA 110 – Engineering Graphics w/Computer Aided Drafting (3 cr.)
- CHE 165 – Chemistry for Engineers (5 cr.)
- PHY 201 – General Physics I (5 cr.)

*Each student must earn a grade of C or better in MAT 221 and MAT 222.

Note: Pre-requisites for professional engineering courses must be completed in addition to meeting the CGPA for enrollment eligibility.

It is understood that students entering with an *Associate of Arts and Science Degree* from the UW-Colleges or a four year UW-System institution, or a *Bachelor's degree* from an accredited institution will have satisfied the General Education requirements for UW-Platteville.
