

UWFV hosts free concert by Gaelic Storm in March

MENASHA — Musical group Gaelic Storm is making an appearance at the University of Wisconsin-Fox Valley at 7 p.m. March 4 in the campus' Fine Arts Theatre.

The performance is sponsored by UWFV's Campus Activities Board and is free and open to the public, with a limited number of seats available through a ticket distribution at the campus.

Gaelic Storm has played at Milwaukee's Irish Fest; the Celtic Fest in Chicago; the Dublin, Ohio, Irish Festival; the Pittsburgh Irish Festival; and the Festival Interceltique in Lorient, France. The group has performed previously at UWFV.

Gaelic Storm achieved international notoriety through its appearance in the blockbuster film "Titanic," portraying the party band in the steerage scene.

The group has released six albums, with the most recent being "Bring Yer Wellies," produced in 2006.

Free tickets to Gaelic Storm's performance may be reserved by UWFV students, with one ticket provided per student identification card. Tickets also can be reserved by the general public beginning with an allowance of two tickets per person. Tickets can be picked up at 4 p.m. the day of the performance. Tickets not picked up by 6:45 p.m. on the day of the performance are scheduled to be released on a first-come, first-served basis prior to the performance.
