Sheila Koplitz, retired choral music teacher and assistant director for the Fox Valley Chorus of Sweet Adelines, was selected to receive the International MENC Award from Sweet Adelines International.

She accepted the award at the recent Sweet Adelines International Convention in Calgary, Alberta, Canada.

Sweet Adelines International is a world-wide organization of women singers committed to advancing the musical art form of barbershop harmony through education and performance.

Koplitz was nominated by the Sweet Adelines Region 22 regional team for the award.

Over the past 25 years, she has worked with students in quartets, octets and various barbershop ensembles for shows, concerts and state con-

tests so that they will carry on the barbershop traditions of the women's and men's organizations – Sweet Adelines International and SPEBSQSA.
